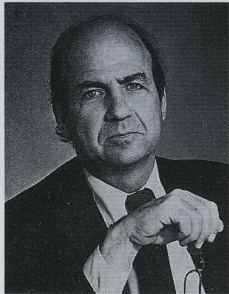
MARGARET THATCHER

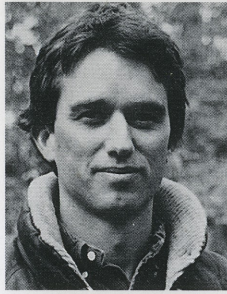
CALVIN TRILLIN

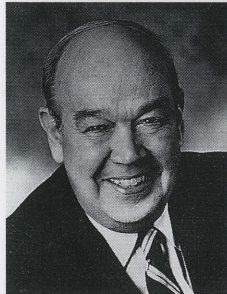

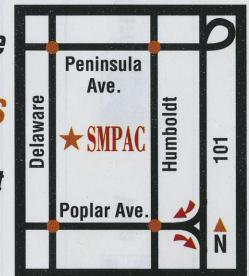
