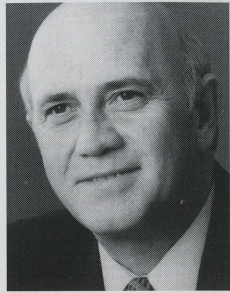


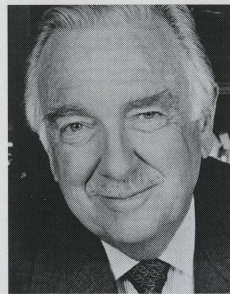

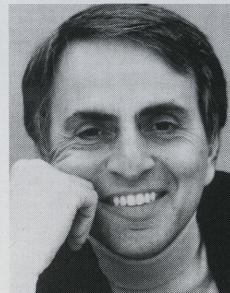

Fri., December 6, 1996, 8:00pm

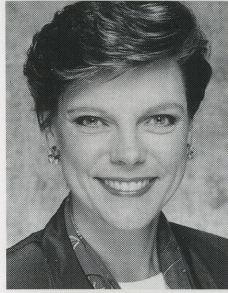
