September 25, 2018  
Tuesday, 8:00 pm

One of National Geographic's most celebrated photographers will share images and stories from her globe-trotting career, taking us from Bedouin campfires to Argentinian horse whisperers. In addition, Griffiths heads Ripple Effect Images, a group of photographers documenting programs that empower women and girls throughout the developing world.



James Comey

Comey was appointed Deputy US Atty General by President Bush and FBI Director in 2013 by President Obama where he enjoyed wide support by the Agency. Amidst political storms regarding the investigations into Russian meddling in the 2016 election, he was fired by President Trump, resulting in the hiring of Robert Mueller as special prosecutor.



John Chambers

Chambers joined Cisco Systems in 1991 and became CEO in 1995 when Cisco was a \$70 million company. Under his leadership Cisco became a \$50 billion company and was instrumental in bringing the Internet to the masses. Burns' name is synonymous with outstanding documentary filmmaking. He is creator, director and producer of a series of award-winning programs covering topics ranging from jazz to baseball, and the Civil War to our National Parks. Burns is the recipient of Academy Awards, Emmy Awards and Grammy Awards, spanning the film, television and music industries.



Vice President Joe Biden

November 27, 2018 – Tuesday, 8:00 pm

As a senator from Delaware for 36 years, Biden was a leading architect of domestic policy, a preeminent voice on criminal justice issues, worked to change the culture around domestic violence and sexual assault, and played a pivotal role in shaping U.S. foreign policy.

While 47th vice president of the United States, Biden oversaw implementation of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, chaired an administration-wide effort to improve the lives of working men and women, and led efforts to implement reforms to reduce gun violence. He was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom, with Distinction — the highest U.S. civilian honor.

Today, Vice President Biden continues expanding opportunity for all through the Biden Foundation, the Penn Biden Center for Diplomacy and Global Engagement, and the Biden Institute for Domestic Policy at the University of Delaware.

Biden is the author of *"Promise Me, Dad: A Year of Hope, Hardship, and Purpose"*, a memoir released in 2017, and *"Promises to Keep: On Life and Politics"*.
